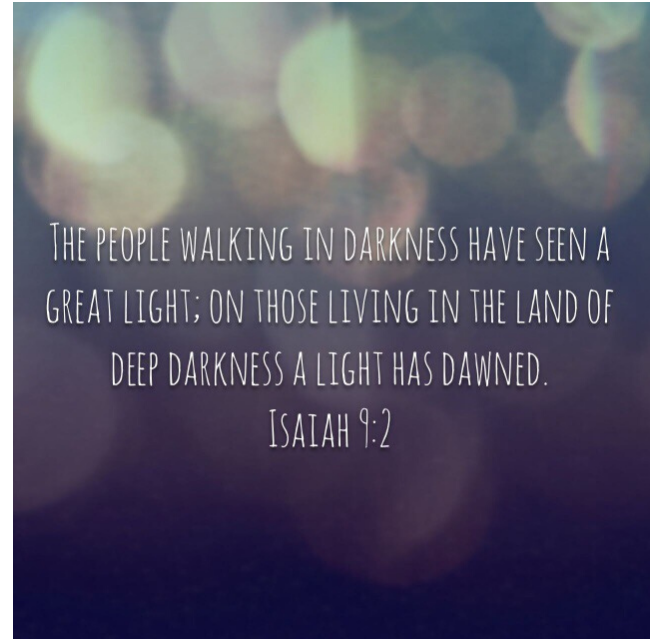
Birthday Blessing
